

Brien McMahon High School Student Prom Contract

Junior Prom: May 8, 2009 7-11 p.m. Senior Prom: May 29, 2009 7-12 p.m.

I understand that the end of the year "Prom" dance and dinner activity is a school sponsored event and a privilege to attend. I understand and will abide by the following rules and behavioral expectations. I also understand that it is my responsibility to inform my guest of the following regulations:

1. All financial obligations owed to BMHS must be paid before the purchase of any tickets. An official signed and stamped "Obligations Paid" slip must be obtained from Mrs. Knox in the bookkeeper's office.
2. "Prom" tickets cannot be resold. Class advisors are to be contacted if any problems arise. Student "date" changes must be reported to the advisors. Students must report to check-in table upon arrival.
3. All students must be present in school for at least 4.5 hours (Pers. 1-5) and must arrive at school on time on the day of the prom. Tardy students must complete 4.5 hours before any early dismissal.
4. Early dismissal notes must be submitted to the Junior or Senior Housemaster's secretary, BY WEDNESDAY of "Prom" week. Students may do so early. There will be no exceptions. Students must make appointments after 12 p.m.
5. Early dismissal will only be allowed after period 5 at 11:59 on the day of the event for students who have brought in authenticated notes. Excused absences will be granted for periods 6 and 7, but these absences count toward the total of eight. Students who are absent on the day of the prom may not attend the prom.
6. Arrive no later than 9:00 p.m. Parents of students who have not arrived by 8:30 p. m. will receive a phone call. Students arriving after 9:00 p.m. will not be admitted to the prom.
7. There will be no adult supervision, police or BMHS staff, after 11:30 p.m. for the Junior Prom and 12:30 a.m. for the Senior Prom.
8. Students are expected to behave according to the "Code of Conduct" of the Norwalk Bd. of Ed. Any kind of inappropriate language, physical displays, smoking, and the use of alcohol or other illegal substances will not be tolerated. The parents of students who behave inappropriately will be contacted and asked to come and pick up their child.
9. Alcohol or other illegal substances are prohibited at the prom and in transport to or from the prom. Party vans, limos, etc. may be searched by the security guards upon arrival. Any one person found with any banned substance will cause all of the passengers in that vehicle to be denied entrance to the prom. Parents will be called and asked to come and pick up their children. Students may be subject to arrest for serious breaches of the rules.
10. Students should dress appropriately and according to the code of conduct, (no sneakers, jeans, boots, etc.)
11. Once students enter the prom, they are not allowed to leave temporarily. If anyone needs to return to their car, they will be escorted by security or a BMHS staff member.
12. Once a student leaves the prom unescorted, s/he cannot re-enter the prom.
13. NO packages, large bags, backpacks, bottles, are allowed in the prom.
14. Students should exercise discretion in the way they dance at this formal activity. Sexually suggestive dancing will be identified and discouraged.
15. It is the responsibility of the student purchasing the prom tickets to review this contract with any guest not attending BMHS. Please complete the information below and be sure to sign the contract.
